Did you know that the new Gluten-Free Certification Program (version 3) was published in February 2019 by BRCGF. As of August 1, 2019, all GFCP audits will be conducted with the new version of the program. Are you ready?

WHAT IS THE GFCP?

The Gluten-Free Certification Program (GFCP) is the only program offered on a voluntary basis to gluten-free food, drugs and pharmaceuticals manufacturers recommended in Canada and the United States by the two main organizations namely the Canadian Celiac Association (CCA) and Beyond Celiac (formerly the National Foundation for Celiac Awareness):

- > Simple and safe identification of gluten-free products as opposed to company self- declarations;
- > The only certification program that satisfies and exceeds government rules for gluten-free labeling claims;
- > Aligned with proven and internationally recognized food safety standards such as HACCP and GFSI.

- Annual certification audits are performed by independent, ISO accredited licensed certification bodies whose approved auditors are trained to ensure the safety of gluten-free products. This third-party relationship is required to eliminate any potential conflict of interest.
- > As opposed to other gluten-free claims, the GFCP standard does not rely solely on analytical testing results.
